3 weeks 6 weeks

Those who has completed 12 year school curriculum in Japan or outside of Japan and are entitled for University Admission at your own country .

Those who are scheduled to complete 12 year school curriculum in Japan or outside of Japan before the program starts and are entitled for University Admission at your own country or persons equivalent thereto.
